## $\underline{\text{COVID}}$ -19 INFECTION, PREVENTION AND CONTROL (IPC) MEASURES IN READINESS FOR THE 63 $^{\text{RD}}$ GRADUATION CEREMONY

The above subject refers

The health safety IPC measures should include the following;

- 1. Venue Preferably open area for ventilation and flow of air
- 2. Respiratory Hygiene-Mandatory use of masks by all without lowering them to the chins
- 3. Hand Hygiene Provision of hand washing facilities (preferably the automated one to avoid contamination from touching the taps and soap dispensers)/ hand sanitizers at various entry/ designated points
- 4. Screening at the entrances points. Temperature checks using infrared gun thermometers and enquiring about COVID-19 symptoms or history of contact with suspected or confirmed COVID-19 cases
- 5. Safety Distance:

Physical - Provide clear marking for physical distancing of at least 1.5 meters Social - NO social gathering or person to person contact before or after the graduation

6. Avoid person to person contact or touching shared documents.

Sign of non-contact greetings to be displayed at various strategic places

No sharing of graduation booklets and issuance of papers/certificates from one person to another

- 7. Procession Ensure there is adequate physical/social distance
- 8. Disinfection:

Disinfection of the graduation square before the function, all surfaces, chairs and light switches Disinfection of mics and podium after every speaker.

- 9. Ablution blocks- Ensure controlled use of ladies and gents plus regular cleaning of the facilities and disinfection of the surfaces, doorknobs and light switches
- 10. Persons with Disabilities (PWD)-Provide the necessary support to PWD
- 11. Waste disposal- Provision of lined waste collection dust bins placed at various designated areas preferably pedal ones to avoid touching
- 12. Population At most 100 persons. Those above 58 years and with preexisting conditions to stream live
- 13. Evacuation of medical emergencies ACLS ambulance to support evacuation of critical emergencies

14. Duration of the function – At most 2 hours.
